

Bryan County Board of Commissioners – Special Called Meeting – April 2, 2026

A Special Called Meeting of the Bryan County Board of Commissioners was held on Tuesday, April 2, 2026, at 3:30 p.m. in Richmond Hill, in the Commission Meeting Room. The following members were present in person: Chairman Carter Infinger, Commissioner Gene Wallace, Commissioner Alex Floyd, Commissioner Jeff Nielsen, Commissioner Patrick Kisgen and Commissioner Wade Price. Also present: County Administrator Ben Taylor, County Clerk Lori Tyson and County Attorney Aaron Kappler.
