

Building and Construction Board of Appeals – Special Called Meeting – June 9, 2026

The Special Called Meeting of the Building and Construction Board of Appeals was held on Tuesday, June 9, 2026, in Richmond Hill at 5:00 p.m. The following members were present in person: Chairman Carter Infinger, Commissioner Alex Floyd, Commissioner Wade Price, Commissioner Jeff Nielsen, and Commissioner Patrick Kisgen. Also present: County Attorney Aaron Kappler, County Administrator Ben Taylor and County Clerk Lori Tyson. Commissioner Gene Wallace was present virtually.

Chairman Carter Infinger called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

A motion was made by Alex Floyd and seconded by Patrick Kisgen to approve the agenda. Vote 5:0, motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Patrick Kisgen and seconded by Alex Floyd to approve the minutes of the April 14, 2026 meeting, with a minor spelling correction in paragraph three. Vote 5:0, motion carried unanimously.

Attorney Aaron Kappler advised the Board that, following the County's issuance of a surface mining violation and stop-work order, the site has since been stabilized. He further reported that a settlement agreement had been reached with Mr. Galbreath in the amount of \$7,600.

A motion was made by Jeff Nielsen and seconded by Alex Floyd to approve the settlement of the appeal by accepting \$7,600 as full payment of the administrative fine. Vote 5:0, motion carried unanimously.
